1) Sensitization on FDC (fixed dose combination) regimen for T.B. Patients under RNTCP, held on 28th July 2016 in MMMCH, Solan

CME regarding daily regimen employing FDC (fixed dose combination) for T.B. patients was organized on **28th July 2016** in MMMCH, Solan. CME was inaugurated by Dr Kiranjeet Kaur, Principal, MMMCH, Solan. Faculty members from all departments attended the workshop. Deliberations on various aspects of the programme were made in collaboration with eminent facilitators from state task force HP and WHO -RNTCP medical consultant. This training programme was awarded **two credit hours** by Himachal Pradesh Medical Council.

The faculty members from all departments attended the workshop. 5. CME on World AIDS Day, held on 1st December, 2015

Various aspects of AIDS & its management were discussed in the CME including HIV & TB Correlation, Diagnostic Dilemma & National guidelines on HIV and Recent advances in management of HIV/AIDS. 6. Zonal Operational Research workshop (North Zone Workshop) on RNTCP held on 15th -17th October 2015.

MMMCH, Solan in collaboration with **National Health Mission & State Task Force on RNTCP Himachal Pradesh**, Organized Zonal Operational Research workshop (North Zone) from **15th -17th October 2015**. The Workshop involved more than 60 Medical Colleges of UP, Delhi, Uttarakhand, Haryana, Punjab, Himachal Pradesh, Chandigarh and Jammu & Kashmir. About 100 delegates from various Medical colleges, RNTCP WHO Consultants and State TB officers participated in the workshop. Dr. U.D. Gupta, Senior Scientist and public health expert from JALMA, Agra was the guest of honour for the workshop. The chief guest Dr. Rohit Sareen, Director, LRS institute of TB and Respiratory disease, Delhi emphasized on need for operational research in TB. Dr Kiranjeet Kaur, Principal, MMMCH, Solan welcomed and stressed upon the need of support from state officials to scale up RNTCP in our institution. The support extended by the Management and the Faculty of Institution in convening the workshop was highly acknowledged by State Authorities. State Task Force in coordination with MMMCH,

Solan, State & District Authorities announced that they will plan more projects in near future.

7. Training cum sensitization on RNTCP by state task force H.P. held on 19th September, 2015

Ever since Revised National TB Control Program (RNTCP) was launched in the Institution in Oct, 2014; various activities have been undertaken. A core committee has been established to review the Program and meeting of core committee was convened on 3rd August, 2015. The Institution also organized State Task Force (STF) meeting to review the activities of three Medical Colleges in the State on 19th September, 2015. A sensitization training program was undertaken by Dr. Pramod K Shridhar, Head of Department (TB and Chest) to aware the Faculty and Staff Nurses of the Institution regarding diagnostics and management of TB. The program on Tuberculosis has gradually scaled up with the implementation of a robust referral system and improvement in referrals of chest symptomatic from various departments of the Institution. The number of OPD & IPD T.B. cases have also increased during the last 6 months. IEC material have been installed by college authorities & placed at strategic places to create awareness about the program.

6. Conference on infertility and workshop on IUI held on 12th -13th September, 2015

The inaugural Chapter of Himachal Pradesh- Indian Fertility Society, HP State Gynecologist, HP Chapter-IFS-2015 was held on **12th -13th September 2015** by Deptt. of Obstetrics & Gynecology, MMMCH, Kumarhatti, Solan in collaboration with HP Chapter IFS.
